



House broken into at Coosan

Local Gardai and fire services were called when a house in Coosan area was broken into in the early hours of yesterday morning.

According to a spokesperson for Athlone Fire Station fire services were first on the scene at around 3.27am after Top Security, the company assigned to the alarm system in the house, called the station reporting a problem with the smoke alarm.

When the fire brigade arrived at the scene it was immediately clear that the house had in fact been broken into.

Sgt. Nicholas Farrell of Athlone Garda Station stated that Gardai received a call at 4am. When Gardai arrived to the scene they reported that the front door of the house had been left open.

The exact details of the break-in are unavailable at present. Gardai are investigating the incident further.
