# Parents set to 'spy' via kids' phones

PARENTS will soon be able use their teenage children's mobile phones to check where their youngsters are.

Dublin firm Top Security says parents will be able to track their children's mobile phone signals from next month.

The service — which could cost around €100 a year — operates via the Internet.

## **Security**

The company says only people with special passwords will be able to use the Web site.

Children will be told if they are to be monitored via text messages on their phones — but will not know exactly when.

A spokeswoman said more details would be available soon.

"There are privacy matters to be considered," she said.

"Pricing has not yet been confirmed and we are still road-testing it."
